As we know Sir, online classes require us to attend class through online meeting conferences such as google meet or zoom, submit assignments through word files, and digital outputs which require resources such as a quality laptop and stable internet connection, both of which I had a difficulty obtaining. Truthfully, my only excuse is that I had to focus on my mental health and contemplate about the things I truly wanted to do as well as regain hope and strength from what I had experienced, that is why I delayed and made excuses in crafting and submitting the LOA.
