We are pleased to invite you to the 2025 KoRAA Short-term Training Program on Vegetable Breeding Technology, which will be held in Korea from October 20 (Monday) to October 25 (Saturday), 2025. This training is organized under the KoRAA (Korea-Asia Food & Agriculture Cooperation Initiative) Program and jointly implemented by the RDA and the World Vegetable Center Korea Office (WKO).

The main objectives of the training are:

- To share the results of the adaptability evaluation of Korean vegetable varieties conducted in KoRAA member countries;
- To provide technical knowledge on vegetable breeding and cultivation;
- To strengthen research capacity and cooperation among KoRAA member countries.

The 6-day training will include technical lectures, institutional visits, cultural experiences, and participation in the 2025 Korea Seed Expo. Participants will also have the opportunity to visit seed companies and advanced agricultural research institutes to gain practical insights into Korea's vegetable breeding programs.

All expenses related to international airfare, accommodation, meals, and domestic transportation during the training period will be fully covered by the World Vegetable Center Korea Office (WKO).

#### 1. Project Outline

## 1) Objectives

- Enhancing the efficiency of the Rural Development Administration (RDA)'s ODA program through capacity building for researchers in Asian countries and the establishment of an R&D cooperation network between RDA and KoRAA member countries
- Competency-building training for participants includes enhancing cultivation techniques using new vegetable varieties (F1 hybrids), attending the Korea Seed Expo 2025, and participating in field trips to seed companies and research institutes.
- 2) Period: March to December 2025 (10 months)
- 3) Participants: 15 PIs (or people in charge of the program) from 7 KoRAA member countries
  - \* Indonesia, Mongolia, Myanmar, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Vietnam
- 4) Implementing agency

- 1) New Variety Adaptability Evaluation
  - Main activities: Regional adaptability evaluation of Korean superior vegetable crops in the KoRAA member countries
  - Support for vegetable cultivation technologies (cabbage, onion, pepper, tomato) and specialized training in vegetable cultivation, tailored to the needs of member countries, if any.
  - Guidelines for reporting the characterization of agronomic traits in various crops.
  - Implementation period: March to December 2025, 10 months
