In addition, may we request that the mode of payment for AER/COLLABDev's use of the facilities be made through the Billing Statement scheme as it will take long for AER to process cash advances for their week-long event in their Visayas project sites.

Re: Request to use VSU Baybay Campus Facilities for the COLLABDev National Assembly and Related Activities

Dear Dr. Tulin,

We are happy to note that the Coalescing Organizations Towards Locally Led Action to Boost Development (COLLABDev), a partnership project of Action for Economic Reforms (AER) and the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), will be completing its second annual implementation plan in September. We thank the Visayas State University for being an integral part of this project, particularly for its role as the local resource organization for Inopacan, Tanauan and Tolosa.

To celebrate this milestone, COLLABDev will have its Second National Assembly on September 19, 2022. While this will be a blended event, we also hope to have a physical setup that will accommodate representatives from the ten project sites and our other data, technology and policy partners. We hope to hold the event in Eastern Visayas where half (five out of ten) of the COLLABDev project sites are.

AER, together with the COLLABDev Local Coordinator for Eastern Visayas, the Environmental Legal Assistance Center headed by Dr. Buenaventura Dargantes, evaluated potential venues for the event. We looked at physical facilities, ICT capacity, as well the overall environment for learning and exchange. The VSU main campus in Baybay City came highly recommended.

We hereby request the use of the VSU facilities for the National Assembly and related events. We will be needing the following:

- For the September 19 National Assembly:
 - a conference hall that can accommodate 100-120 participants in a safe sociallydistanced way;
 - o an exhibit hall, preferably attached to or near the conference hall;
 - o a dining hall, preferably attached to or near the conference hall; and
 - living accommodations for around 60 visiting participants on September 18 or 19.
- For the COLLABDev Pause and Reflect Activity:
 - a meeting hall that can accommodate 25-30 participants in a safe sociallydistanced way;
 - for select days only, a dining hall, preferably attached to or near the conference hall;
 - o living accommodations for 20 persons from September 20-24 (4 nights); and
 - living accommodations for 5-10 persons from September 17-24 (7 nights).

The COLLABDev Admin Team and our Local Coordinator will be happy to discuss the specific details, costs and requirements for the event and related activities with their VSU counterparts once we get your approval of this request.

We hope that you will consider our request kindly and allow COLLABDev partners to enjoy the facilities and ambiance of the VSU main campus for its National Assembly and related activities.

Please also expect a separate letter from us about co-organizing a panel in the National Assembly and a request for you to deliver one of the Welcome Remarks.
