Dear Dr. Tulin:

Good day to you!

I am Frances Kristine de Veyra, a student of the Doctor of Veterinary Medicine during the school year 2019-2020. Due to a severe decline in mental illness, I was not able to perform adequately with my studies. USSO directed me to write this letter in hopes to appeal for readmission to the University for the 2nd Semester of 2021-2022.

I have had a history with mental illness, major depressive disorder and general anxiety specifically, and have been taking steps to handle the situation. When quarantine hit due to the global pandemic, I was barred from my usual support system — meetings with my therapist and close contact with friends. The situation, compounded with the worry for my mostly front lining relatives, caused my mental health to worsen; in an abrupt and desperate attempt to preserve a modicum of sanity, I cut myself off from all forms of communication. This was done midway through the 1st Semester of 2020-2021. I recognize that this decision was misguided and is the cause of my failure to file for a Leave of Absence.

Being able to take the time to reflect on my decisions has given me the opportunity to center myself and grow as an individual. During this time, I have re-established connection with both my psychiatrist and therapist, where we've extensively discussed how I would handle going back to studying during this climate. These sessions have reaffirmed my belief that a higher education is something I still wish to pursue. I hesitate to offer reassurances that I will triumph and win over my misgivings as I know and have lived with being diagnosed for almost 10 years now. It's a struggle. At most, I can offer you that I will try. I will try and persevere despite it.

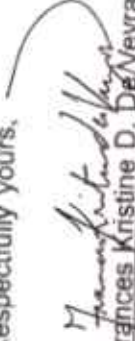
