

Objectives

General:

1. To conserve and maintain (both *ex situ* and *in vitro*) a national abaca genebank.
2. To identify promising high yielding abaca accessions that possess the desired fiber qualities suited to specific end uses for use as parental materials in breeding work and or for further evaluation for possible release as new varieties.

Specific:

1. To collect, conserve and maintain a national abaca genebank in VSU.
2. To determine the morphological characters of the collections.
3. To establish an abaca germplasm database.
