**Title**: Examining the Disaster Preparedness of Disaster Risk Reduction and Management stakeholders in Baybay City, Eastern Visayas, Philippines

## **Abstract**

To reduce disaster risks and build resilience, RA 10121 or the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010 requires the national and local government units to prepare and implement their comprehensive DRRM Plan. The law also mandates the enhancement of the disaster-resilience capacity of the stakeholders, especially the local government units and households who are at the forefront of risks and risk reduction. Capacity-building requires a comprehensive understanding of the hazards, vulnerability, and capacity of the communities. As such, this research examines the current vulnerability and the disaster preparedness capacity of the barangay local government and households in one of the emerging cities in Eastern Visayas Region in the Philippines. The region has suffered enormous life losses and destruction to its natural and built environment in the last decade due to hydrometeorological hazards. It is therefore imperative to understand the current situation of a community before planning and designing capacity-building interventions. In response, this study examines the preparedness of the Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Committees (BRRRMCs) guided by the DILG Project Listo and the current knowledge, attitude, and practices of households in Baybay City. Data collection includes the examination of DRRM Plan of the barangays, a random survey of households, and interviews with the members of BDDRRMC from February to March 2022. Initial study results show that only six out of the 92 barangays of the City have a Barangay DRRM Plan. The primary reason for not being able to formulate is the limited knowledge and resources to prepare it. Meanwhile, the survey also showed the limited knowledge and capacity of households to prepare for impending hazards. Validation of results by the stakeholders is still to be undertaken as it is needed to ascertain the accuracy and ensure the integration of the knowledge of the BDRRMCs and households. The results of this research are expected to inform the concerned LGUs as well as the future research and extension interventions of DRRM actors.
