## Dear President Yepes:

May we recommend the appointment of Dr. Gomathy Palaniappan of the University of Queensland, Brisbane, Australia, as Adjunct Professor effective June 1, 2025 until December 30, 2026. Her engagement with VSU as Adjunct Professor is part of the project, "Managing heavy metals and soil contaminants in vegetable production to ensure food safety and environmental health in the Philippines (SLAM)," jointly implemented by the Visayas State University (VSU), University of the Philippines Los Baños (UPLB), and University of Science and Technology of Southern Philippines (USTP), and funded by the Australian Centre for International Agricultural Research (ACIAR) and DOST-PCAARRD, with a Memorandum of Agreement signed by VSU and its partners.
