I am writing this communication in response to the demand letter which I received last June 15, 2022 regarding my financial liabilities related to my scholarship grant which is CHED K to 12 Transition Program Graduate Scholarship (SGS-L).

The main reason for the non-completion of my graduate degree was the onset of the COVID-19 Pandemic which started just 2 months after my reinstatement on January 2020. Moreover, I was appointed as the Head of the Department of Meteorology (DMet) from July 2020 until March 2022; which adds to my load.
