This is about the INC grades in Ncon 142 of Mr. Nathaniel C. Noya and Ms. Rhea Mae A. Dosdos. The office of the University Registrar did not accept the said submission because it was submitted after the deadline set for the Academic Ease Policy which is the second semester of Academic Year 2021-2022. The deadline was further extended to July 15, 2022.

I received the needed class requirements from these students on July 15 which is still covered within the extended period of the Academic Ease Policy. The submission of grades slipped from my list of to-do tasks because I prioritized the checking of manuscripts of our graduating students, the checking of my current students' class activities/assessments, computing their grades, approval of the thesis, and my administrative function as Head of the department.
