Dear Dr. Tulin:

The NSTP administration has established its *Implementation Plan for the Face-to-Face Training for ROTC Cadet Officer Qualifying Course for the First Semester, School Year: 2022-2023*. The said implementation plan establishes the necessary guidelines and operational framework: Teaching and Learning, Safe School Operations, Well-being and Protection and Contingency Plan.

The COQC training will prepare the aspirants on the rudiments of ROTC, i.e., leadership principles, physical organization, among others. Consequently, the COQC training is a pre-requisite for the officers before they can proceed to ROTC Summer Camp Training (RSCT) and the Philippine Army Advance ROTC Academic Phase Training (PAARAPT). An actual experiential learning of the trainees is needed to prepare them into cadet/cadette officers of the VSU ROTC Unit.

Moreover, this year we are expecting for bigger ROTC enrollees, i.e., 50-60% as compared to 30-50% before pandemic. For this reason, we need more officers. In this connection, we plan for an 80-hours bootcamp type of training, comprising four weekend (Saturdays and Sundays) and 1-hour weekday training. We have conducted almost similar training last semester which we produced topnotchers in the RSCT. For this reason, I believe we are ready for it. Rest assured that NSTP will do its best to implement the training successfully with the commitment to observe the minimum health and safety protocols.

Attached herewith is the Implementation Plan and other documents to support the readiness for the training. We hope these merits your approval. Thank you very much.
