

NOW, THEREFORE, premises considered, the parties hereto hereby agree as they have agreed under the terms and conditions, as follows:

The FIRST PARTY hereby contracts the services of the SECOND PARTY as **Laborers** to perform the functions and deliver the following outputs as follows:

1. Assist in gathering data on the conduct of the Biodiversity Conservation and Management Program for Mt. Pangasugan (BIO-CAMP) Project under the Internationalization Program of VSU;
2. Perform other tasks assigned by supervisors

THAT when the work demand for travel, the SECOND Party shall be entitled to payment of travel expenses (per diem and fare) when travelling on official business within the country subject to existing government accounting rules and regulations and to pertinent VSU policies and rules governing official travel.

THAT the SECOND PARTY shall abide by the rules and regulations of the FIRST PARTY and the terms and conditions as provided for in this service contract and performs the above-listed functions based on the work schedule as prescribed by the hiring department/office/center/unit;

THAT for and in consideration of the foregoing service, the FIRST PARTY binds itself to pay each member of the SECOND PARTY in the amount of **Nine thousand pesos (P9,000.00) per month inclusive of ten percent (10%) premium.**
