**TO THE TEACHER CONCERNED:**

Dear Teachers,

In a letter sent to the Office of the Director of NSTP, the 804<sup>th</sup> Community Defense Center – our partner agency handling the ROTC training – has informed that they *“will conduct the ROTC Summer Camp Training (RSCT CL 01-22) CY 2022 to three hundred eight (308) aspirant Second Class (2CL) and Philippine Army Advance ROTC Academic Phases Training (PAARAPT) (MS 31, 32 & 41 & 42) composed of two hundred ninety-four (294) First Class (1CL) coming from thirteen activated ROTC Units within Region 8 from 06 July 2022 to 03 August 2022 at Republic of Korea Armed Forces (ROKAF) Building Brgy Candahug, Palo, Leyte.* In this training, we have **15 qualifiers** (9 for RSCT and 6 for PAARAPT). This training is pre-requisite for the cadet officers to continue their Advance Officership our Unit. The 804<sup>th</sup> CDC further explained that *“the Objective of this training is to provide the ROTC Cadets/Cadettes knowledge and skills on Military Science and prepared them for military duty as future commissioned officers and enlisted reservists of the Philippine Army.”* Once they can discern for military service, this track is also a great job opportunity.

In this connection, I would like to request that these will be **excused** in their classes on these dates: July 19 – August 3, 2022. Rest assured they will comply with the requirements they will miss during the said period. Attached herewith is the communication letter from the 804<sup>th</sup> CDC and the list of students.
