1 MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING 2 VISAYAS STATE UNIVERSITY (VSU), an institution of higher learning established under Pres. 3 Decree No. 470 as amended by Pres. Decree No. 700, and converted into a state university by virtue of 4 5 RA. 9158 and 9437, with principal office at Visca, Baybay City, Leyte, Philippines represented by its 6 University President, Dr. EDGARDO E. TULIN, 7 8 AND 9 10 YALE UNIVERSITY (Yale), a not-for-profit corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of a special charter and act of the general assembly of the Colony and State of Connecticut in 11 12 the United States of America located in New Haven, Connecticut on behalf of the Yale School of the 13 Environment ("YSE"). 14 15 Visayas State University ("VSU") and Yale University ("Yale") on behalf of its Yale School of the Environment ("YSE") (hereinafter "the Parties"), in the firm conviction that academic 16 17 collaboration between the two Parties will further their educational missions, hereby conclude the 18 following Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). 19 20 21 Article 1. The parties agree to collaborate on research, capacity-building, internships, and training 22 programs on Rainforestation and related resource management fields, including forest 23 ecology, agriculture, hydrology, soils, social ecology, economics, silviculture, and land tenure. This includes, but is not limited, to the training, leadership, and international online 24 25 program activities of the Environmental Leadership & Training Initiative (Yale-ELTI), one of the Yale School of the Environment's centers and programs, as currently implemented in 26 27 the Philippines by the Forest Foundation Philippines. 28 29 Article 2. The terms and conditions of any specific program or activity shall be discussed between 30 individual departments and shall be recorded in a writing signed by the academic liaisons 31 listed below prior to the start of the specific program or activity. 32 33 Article 3. In the case that any specific program or activity results in or impacts upon matters of intellectual property rights arising there from, the Parties shall discuss in good faith and agree 34 35 in a writing signed by the academic liaisons listed below the conditions regarding the 36 treatment of intellectual property rights so arising, prior to the start of the specific program or 37 activity. 38 39 Article 4. Neither Party shall use the name or marks of the other in any press materials or web-based or 40 other publication without the prior written permission of the other Party; provided that each Party may include the name of the other on any routinely-maintained published list of 41 institutional collaborations during the term of this MOU. 42 43 44 Article 5. This MOU is valid for a period of five (5) years from February 1, 2023 to January 31, 2028 (the "term"). The Term of the MOU may be extended by a writing signed by both Parties. Either 45 46 Party may terminate the MOU during its Term for any reason by giving sixty (60) days 47 advance written notice to the other Party and the Parties agree to engage in a reasonable negotiation regarding the winding up of any collaborative projects. 48 49

Article 6. The academic liaison for Yale will be Dr. Eva Garen and the academic liaison for VSU will be Dr. Eliza Espinosa. Any notice given under this MOU shall be (i) personally delivered, (ii)
