I am Mario Pajuyo Jr a 5th year Civil Engineering student wants to apply for a readmission for this coming 2nd semester of school year 2021 – 2022. I had stopped attending school at VSU during the 2nd semester of school year 2020 – 2021.

The reason is that I have suffered a certain health condition last August 2020. During that time, I have experienced difficulty in swallowing food, stomach pain, frequent vomiting, and bowel movement difficulty. Due to pandemic and financial problem, it takes 4 months before I was examined by an Internal Medicine Specialist at Living Hope Hospital in Maasin City. Base on the tests (endoscopy and colonoscopy) conducted by the doctor last December 05, 2020, I have suffered an esophagitis (Grade A) at my esophagus, gastric ulcer and gastritis in my stomach and internal hemorrhoids (Grade 1 -2) with non – specific colitis at my colon. I was advised by the doctor to take a lot rest, eat nutritious and healthy foods, take proper medication and avoid stressful situation. Because of the doctor's advise, I refrain the things and situation that can make my health condition worse including the use of cell phone. That is why for several months I have been cut from the updates including my standing in my deffered subject (CE Correlation) and the steps needed in order to file a leave of absence.

As months passed by, my health continued to improve and is much better right now. Even though I am not yet 100% healthy (because sometimes I still vomit especially after eating, suffered stomach pain and easily get tired), I hope that you would grant my request for readmission for this incoming semester. It is because CE Correlation is the only subject that I needed in order to graduate and I think I can be able to manage the said subject this semester. I will assure you that I will give my best to do my studies well for this subject.


