



## PROPOSAL TO OFFER NSTP GRANT TO QUALIFIED NSTP OFFICERS

### RATIONALE

The purpose of NSTP is stated in section 2 of RA 9163. It says that the law was passed to: 1) promote civic consciousness among the youth, 2) develop the youth's physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being, 3) inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism, and 4) advance the youth's involvement in public and civic affairs. Section 2 of the same law states that "in pursuit of these goals, the youth, the most valuable resource of the nation, shall be motivated, trained, organized and mobilized in military training, literacy, civic welfare and similar endeavors in the service of the nation.

As a support, the University through the National Service Training Program should entice service-oriented students to become officers to serve the trainees. One way is to grant stipend to sustain their involvement as officers.

As observed, there is a dwindling number of officers. Often cited reasons were priority on academic demands and limited financial support. Before the free tuition fee law implementation, the University has been supporting deserving ROTC officers through ROTC Grant - free tuition fee incentive. The grant has been productive to sustain our officers. But with free tuition fee law, the ROTC Grant is no longer applicable. It is our appeal to modify the grant. The NSTP Office proposed to offer NSTP Grant to qualified officers.

### OBJECTIVE/LEARNING OUTCOME

The NSTP Grant will attract potential student leaders to join the NSTP corps of officers, i.e., CWTS and ROTC Officers

### COVERAGE

The NSTP Grant will cover both CWTS and ROTC Officers, i.e. basic, advance and graduate military assistants

### Guidelines, Qualifications and Requirements

#### a. CWTS Officers

1. The grantee shall be duly elected from each team as President, Vice President, Secretary-Treasurer and PIO.
2. The grantee shall undergo Leadership Training to be conducted by the Civic Welfare Training Service Unit and shall present the Certificate of Completion.
3. The grantee shall present an appointment and oath of office.
4. The grantee shall maintain a good academic performance. However, if he/she incurred one failure or one INC grade, but not both, the Officer can still qualify for the grant provided he/she shall write an action plan to make up for the missed learning opportunity.
5. The grantee can apply in the second semester of that school year.
6. Grantee will receive a monthly stipend of P500.00.
