Dear Dr. Colorado,

Submitting herewith our reply to the recommendations/observations of the Technical Committee for Food Science and Technology for the Institution's application for the issuance of COPC for MS in Food Science and Technology program effective AY 2021-2022.

Based on the results, we still need to comply with 2 issues: first, relative to the specialization of the members of the thesis/dissertation panel, and second, the ethical standards. As of the moment, we can only address the first, which is the fields of specialization for the members of the thesis/dissertation panel. However, on the second issue related to the ethical standards, we cannot submit yet the documentary evidence of approved ethics guidelines for human and animals for research since the university is currently working on it.

In this connection, I would like to request a six-month extension for the university to comply with the said recommendation.
