- 4. Present a paper in the regional/national R&D Symposia/fora (as scheduled by Consortium/National agency concerned with prescribed standard format);
- 5. Submit terminal report three (3) months after completion of the research project;
- 6. Publish articles of significant research findings in indexed/peer-reviewed journals.
