Our commitment to develop VSU's component colleges into BIDANI project implementers is being operationalized through the conduct of capacity building activities on the three components—BIDA, BMIS, and PNEA—that comprise BIDANI's corporate identity. Following the BIDANI process, we have successfully conducted the first two training-workshops in July and August 2022 that was attended by the BIDANI project team from each component college or about 20 participants per training.

Training-Workshop on BIDA Implementation

Rationale

BIDANI is a collaborative extension and action research program initiated by SUCs and implemented in barangays in partnership with LGUs and other stakeholders. The primary vision of BIDANI is to achieve nutritional improvement, self-sufficiency, and improved quality of life at the village level through the integration of development efforts by all government and nongovernment agencies.

In our commitment to develop VSU's four component colleges into BIDANI implementers, this year, we at VSU Main are conducting a series of capacity building activities considering that as a development program and strategy, BIDANI has three components—BIDA, BMIS, and PNEA—that comprise its corporate identity. Two training-workshops have already been conducted for the BIDANI project teams in the component colleges. These are the BIDANI Program Orientation held on July 21-22, 2022 and BMIS Establishment on August 22-23, 2022. The participants appreciate these two training-workshops as they are bent on implementing BIDANI in their respective municipalities in partnership with the LGUs.

The third training-workshop is on the Barangay Integrated Development Approach (BIDA) component of BIDANI. It will be conducted on September 29-30, 2022 at the ISRDS Training Room. The BIDANI project team per component college will again be invited as participants.

Objectives

Generally, the training-workshop aims to enhance the capacity of the VSU component colleges to implement the Barangay Integrated Development Approach (BIDA) as a component of the BIDANI extension project. Specifically, the training-workshop aims to:

- Articulate the BIDA process as an essential component of the BIDANI strategy for development;
- 2) Detail the steps in coming up with the Barangay Integrated Development Plan (BIDP) that harmonizes other developmental plans such as Barangay Nutrition Action Plan (BNAP), Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction Management, Gender and Development Plan, Annual Investment Plan, and other required plans at the barangay LGU level;

3) Develop the knowledge and skills of the participants in collaboration and linkaging, advocacy, and sustaining of active and coordinated participation of various sectors to facilitate the implementation of the BIDANI strategy to make sure that all developmental plans and programs are meaningful, sustainable, and responsive to and reflective of the actual conditions and needs of the communities.

Methodology/Strategy

Lectures, small group discussions, and workshops will be employed.

Participants are well versed with the BIDA approach including the generation of different plans such as the Barangay Integrated Development Plan (BIDP), Barangay Nutrition Action Plan (BNAP), Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction Management, Gender and Development Plan, Annual Investment Plan, and other required plans at the barangay LGU level. The participants will also learn the essential skills for collaborating and working with their respective LGU partners and other stakeholders.
