The Department of Liberal Arts and Behavioral Sciences (DLABS) is currently developing a new program offering, that is, Bachelor of Arts in Literature, major in Literary and Cultural Studies (AB Literature). One of the items required in the proposal is a list of library holdings in literature and other subjects to be taught in the first two years of the program.

Courses to be offered in the first year of the program include General Education (GE) courses such as Purposive Communication, Readings in Philippine History, Mathematics in the Modern World, Art Appreciation, Understanding the Self, Ethics, Contemporary World, and Science, Technology, and Society.
