Dear *Dr. Tulin*,

This is in relation to the recently attended Online Basic Training Course for Pollution Control Officers by the three (3) members of the VSU Waste Management Committee last March 21 – 25, 2022. One of the important points learned in the training was that there was really a need for us to conduct inventory on VSU's waste generation and other facilities in compliance with the requirements of PD 1586, RA 6969, RA 8749, RA 9003, RA 9275, their respective implementing rules and regulations (IRRs), and for the University's ECC application as required by DENR-EMB.

To maximize the time, the said inventory will be conducted by our **BSES 4th year students** as one of their course requirements on Envi. 124 (Environmental Impact Assessment), Envi. 118 (Envi. Monitoring) and Ecology 21 (Fundamentals of Ecology) under the supervisions of Engr. Jimmy O. Pogosa, Dr. Angelica P. Baldos, and yours truly, who are also members of the VSU Waste Management Committee and Pollution Control Team (WMPCT).

Relative to this, we would like to ask permission that these students will be allowed to conduct the said waste generation inventory and visit all departments, colleges, research facilities, offices, dormitories, cottages, residential or apartments, recreational areas, accommodation areas, fast foods, VSU-PAG-ASA Agromet Station, and other common areas within VSU starting this 1st week of May until 1st week of June 2022.
