Sir., I am holding on to Filipino saying "kung gusto, may paraan", "kung kinaya nila, kakayanin mo rin". I remembered my classmates who were Super Typhoon Haiyan Survivors, they all graduated despite losing a family member, their homes and their books. If they can, then I have no reason sir to not pursue too.

During my days at the university, despite not having an impressive grades, I was able to top some of my exams; botany, anatomy (DAS), poultry production & mgmt. (DAS), swine production & mgmt. (DAS), etc. My classmates can attest to that. If I was able to do that before, sir, I can assure you that I will do the same if I'll be granted re-admission to this university.
