## Dear Dr. Tulin:

This is to recommend the appointment of Dr. Anatolio N. Polinar as a Study Leader of "Important Timber Species in selected sites in Mt. Pangasugan, VSU Baybay City, Leyte" under the approved VSU research project/study "Biodiversity Conservation and Management Program of Mt. Pangasugan (BIO-CAMP)" (Project Code: VSU-IP-2021-10), without honorarium effective immediately until December 31, 2022.

As a study leader, he is expected to perform the following responsibilities with appropriate workload unit equivalent:

- 1. Collect data on important timber species in selected sites in Mt. Pangasugan;
- 2. Exercise supervision and control in the implementation of the study;
- 3. Submit report on the significant outputs/outcome of all components;
- 4. Submit quarterly research progress reports to the OVPREI-RPO (Attachment 1).
- 5. Submit midyear research progress reports every 1st week of July of every year (Attachment 2).
- 6. Submit annual research progress reports every 1st week of January of the succeeding year (Attachment 3).
- 7. Present the research highlights or papers during the Research In-house Review and Evaluation (Attachment 4).
- 8. Present a paper in the regional/ national R&D Symposia/fora (as scheduled by Consortium/National agency concerned with prescribed standard format).
- 9. Submit terminal report three (3) months after completion of research project (Attachment 5).
- 10. Publish articles of significant research findings in indexed / peer reviewed journals
- 11. Do other tasks as may be required by the program leader and higher authorities.

In case of any changes in the title, methodology, project site, and /or budget the approval should first be sought from the University President upon recommendation by the concerned College Dean or Center Director and the Vice-President for Research, Extension, and Innovation.
