Implementing Guidelines of the VSU Rice Production Project

I. Qualification of the Rice Farmer Cultivator

- 1. The rice cultivator should preferably be a job order laborer or a retired employee of VSU, with a minimum of two years of experience in rice production.
- 2. The farmer cultivator should preferably be residing at the barangay or adjacent barangays where the VSU rice farm is located.
- The interested farmer should submit their application to the rice production manager and await the scheduled interview before contract signing.

II. Prescribe Rice Farming Practices by the Rice Farmer Cultivator

- 1. The farmer cultivators should adopt the VSU rice production technology especially on the use of quality seeds of recommended variety in Region 8.
- The farmer cultivators must inform VSU, through the designated production manager at least three (3) days before planting and harvesting. No harvesting shall be scheduled on a weekend or holiday.

III. Palay Sharing Scheme between VSU and the Rice Farmer Cultivator

- A palay sharing of 1:3 ratio taken from the gross palay yield will be followed, where VSU
 as the owner of the rice production area will receive one (1) share for every 3 shares
 received by the rice farmer cultivator.
- 2. The cultivator must turnover to VSU its intended palay share no more and no less during harvesting.

IV. Renewal and Termination as Rice Farmer Cultivator

- 1. The cultivator should inform the designated production manager of their intent to renew the contract thirty (30) days before its termination.
- VSU has the right to terminate the contract if and when the rice farmer-cultivator fails to implement the prescribed VSU production technologies.
- 3. VSU has the right to terminate the contract at any time should the rice farm be needed for research, production, or construction purposes.

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
