I. Physical accomplishments within the 3rd quarter

A. Targets for the quarter

Component 1: Production and distribution of NSIC-recommended registered and certified rice and corn seeds

- Planting of lowland rice NSIC Rc402 for seed production during the wet cropping season.

Component 2: Training and technical assistance on climate-smart production systems of agronomic field crops anchored in combating climate change

- Conduct of the second batch of rice production training for rice farmers and other stakeholders in Albura, Leyte.

Component 3: Production and distribution of certified planting materials for legumes and root crop varieties

- Planting of mungbean, peanut, and root crops (sweet potato, gabi, etc.) during the wet cropping season for planting material production intended for low-income farmers, students, and other stakeholders.

Component 4: Design and production of brochures on crop production

- Development of IEC material on rice ratooning technology for distribution in 2024.
