Proposal Title: Policies on Admission, Retention, and Intervention for Bachelor of Science in Chemistry Program

Proponent: Department of Pure and Applied Chemistry

Rationale/Background:

Producing highly competitive and excellent stakeholders is one of the core functions of Visayas State University. Accordingly, the Department of Pure and Applied Chemistry is strengthening its resources to deliver certain outputs concerning this function.

For the past year, the department had observed a significant decrease in the number of students who passed the Chemists Licensure Exam and concluded that there is a need to intensify countermeasures to pull through. Hence, we, at the Department of Pure and Applied Chemistry, propose the creation of policies/guidelines on the admission, retention, and intervention for the undergraduate program offered—Bachelor of Science in Chemistry.

Creating these policies will address the fundamental skills gap for non-STEM enrollees of BS in Chemistry, provide a platform in hastening their knowledge and skills in chemistry, and encourage the students to learn and excel academically. This will also help the students to prepare and pass the professional licensure examination.

OBJECTIVES:

The proposed policies aim to:

1. pipeline fundamental skills gap for non-STEM applicants of BS Chemistry program;
2. encourage the students to have good academic performance in chemistry;
3. deepen/strengthen the knowledge and skills of BS Chemistry students;
4. prepare the BS Chemistry students for the Chemists Licensure Exam (CLE), and
5. increase the number of passers of Chemists Licensure Exam (CLE).
