The MS in Tropical Ecology (MSTREC) and the BS in Environmental Management (BSEM) curricular programs are now AACCUP Level II-accredited, after passing the 2nd Visit Survey conducted on October 1–6, 2018. We received the AACCUP Summary of Findings and Recommendations for Areas I–X, with the extent of compliance of the team's recommendations for Area IV, and the AACCUP Technical Review and Board Action. The two programs are scheduled for Level III accreditation (3rd Visit Survey) come the 3rd week of October 2022.

With the new guidelines in the preparation and conduct of Levels III and IV programs, and with all the requirements in the process to carry-over the accreditation status of BSEM to the BS Environmental Science (BSES) program, more tasks has to be carried-out during the preparation.
