cases in the City of Baybay in the past months now, it is hereby proposed for VSU to

return to face-to-face classes in all curricular programs and in all year levels (graduate

and undergraduate programs, senior and junior high school) starting Midyear 2021-

2022.

For the Midyear term, there are few courses offered, so there will be fewer

students attending face-to-face classes. Some of the third year and graduating

students will be conducting face-to-face internship and practicum courses.
