Swine Technician

Breeding:

- Heat detection through hunch back test and riding the back test.

- Natural breeding - is the more common practice of the farm since the farm has in-house boar and junior boar. The boars are assisted to mount the gilts and sows.
- Pregnant sows and gilts are provided with sufficient care and management until they are about to farrow, including deworming and vitamin supplementation.

Farrowing:

- To-farrow sows and gilts are transferred to the farrowing pens to provide them comfort during farrowing.
- They are assisted during farrowing and are administered with oxytocin and antibiotic, if required.
- Vitamins and supplements are provided to the sows and gilts for faster recovery.

Nursery:

- Care and management of the piglets starts right after they are born. Piglets' nostrils are wiped with clean, dry cloth to remove the mucus and help their respiration, and are placed in a clean, dry, and controlled temperature.
- Umbilical cord cutting, teeth clipping, and tail docking are performed to each piglet, and are ensured to obtain the colostrum from their mother.
- Iron supplementation is given to each piglet at 3 days old.
- Vitamin and vaccination are provided at 1 – 2 weeks.
- Castration and iron booster are provided to piglets at 14 days old.
- Deworming and vitamin are administered during weaning.

Growing/Fattening:

- Care and management to growers and fatteners includes disinfection of pens regularly, as well as bathing the pigs twice a day (morning and afternoon).
- Dewormers are administered at 90 days old.
- Pigs are provided with sufficient feed, water, & vitamins until disposal.
- Oversees the whole farm operations for the family's roasted pig business.

Freelance Swine Technician

- Provide technical assistance to the swine farms of backyard farm owners within the town area from breeding to farrowing to fattening, including assistance of to-farrow sows and gilts, care & management of piglets until weaning that includes assuring each piglet to obtain colostrum, teeth clipping, ear docking, castration, iron & vitamin supplementation, deworming, and vaccination.
- Artificial Insemination – collected semen from desirable sires to generate pigs with superior quality.
- Growers & fatteners are provided with vitamins, vaccinations, dewormer, and medicine if required.

Safety and Operations Training

- Has understood the guidelines for safe handling of tools, machinery, chemicals and miscellaneous equipment (material handling) for safe and successful activities with the goal of operational familiarity.

Poultry Flock Management - Avian Husbandry

- Have had learned and performed the fundamental flock care skills as well as poultry/ avian management necessary for a large poultry facility, including bio-security measures to eliminate the transfer of diseases between poultry locations, and maintaining a clean working environment which is necessary to keep the flock healthy and disease free.
- I have learned and obtained basic avian production & livestock husbandry skills used in the USA and how these skills can increase egg production, as well as the techniques used to ensure fair and ethical treatment of livestock, ensuring best industry standards while working with all livestock and livestock conditions, while following the procedures outlined by the USDA, FDA, and all other Federal, State, and local agencies.

Poultry Feed and Nutrition

- Have had learned the proper nutritional amounts of feed for different types and ages of laying poultry, the daily amount of food for a healthy flock - the quantity of feed, and the nutritional requirements of the feed depending on the weight and age of the poultry, their rate of growth, their rate of egg production and the weather conditions.
- Learned how to use automated feeding and watering systems, record times and amounts and how to ensure adequate food is provided to each bird.

Poultry Flock Management - Data and Documentation

- Learned and obtained a mastery of basic documentation techniques used in a large egg-laying operation.
- Learned to identify the potential problems using historical averages and will learn how to overcome such problems, and how daily activities and how weather conditions can
- influence egg output.

Flock Management - Technology and Automation

- Learned and obtained a mastery of the computer systems used by the company management to track targets vs. actual consumption, usage, egg production, etc.
- Learned how all the various pieces of machinery work together to efficiently handle, transfer and package millions of eggs every day of the year.

- Has observed the packing of refrigerated trucks with pallets of egg boxes and the labelling of egg cartons and understand why it is important to be able to track the customer back to the day/time and location the eggs came from.

Supervision and Poultry Operations Management

- Learned the management techniques and procedures such as inventory of room sheets, weekly spreadsheets keeping track of egg rate per day, track poultry molting, assist in determining when aged birds should be removed from production and when the pullets should be brought in, and other inventory tasks.
