X or R grades not changed upon graduation are excess hours not needed for degree conferral and are no longer in progress. Fall 1976 - Spring 1981, X and WX were used to indicate withdrawal failing and were not used in calculating the GPA. Fall 1988 - Spring 1992, WP was used to indicate withdrawal passing (excluded from GPA) and WF was used to indicate withdrawal failing (equivalent to an F in the GPA). Spring 2020, students were offered the option to elect P/NP grades for courses impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, in accordance with guidance from the OK State Regents for Higher Education. Original grades of D or higher could convert to a P at the undergraduate level, and grades of C or better could convert to a P at the graduate level. All spring 2020 P grades should count toward degree requirements. Some in progress coursework may reflect content taken at another institution with whom Oklahoma State University has a consortium agreement.

ACADEMIC FORGIVENESS: Undergraduate courses that qualify for the repeat policy are designated with the following symbols in the far right repeat column (with a header of R):

- E repeat excluded from earned hours and GPA
- I repeat included in earned hours and GPA
- A repeat included in GPA but excluded from earned hours

Undergraduate courses impacted by academic reprieve/renewal are designated with the following symbols following the letter grade:

- * Courses granted academic reprieve excluded from earned hours and GPA
- ** Courses granted academic renewal excluded from earned hours and GPA

Undergraduate transcripts with no coursework since Fall 1999 may use the following codes instead of the forgiveness notations described above, and may not reflect DEV-, PA-, and CBE- course type symbols.

- * courses that are excluded from the GPA
- # courses granted academic reprieve that are excluded from the GPA
- @ courses repeated that are included in the GPA but excluded from earned hours
- & designated courses excluded from the GPA (developmental/remedial, performance/activity)

COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM: Courses are designated by a subject prefix and a four-digit course number (prior to fall 1967, three-digit course numbers were used). The first digit indicates the class year in which the subject is ordinarily taken, although enrollment is not exclusive to student classification (1 – freshman, 2 – sophomore, 3 – junior, 4 – senior, 5 and 6 – graduate, 7 – professional veterinary medicine). Some courses are approved for multiple levels of credit. Course numbers beginning with 0 indicate developmental courses that do not carry University credit. The last digit of the course number indicates the number of semester credit hours. Course numbers ending with 0 indicate a variable credit course.

TRANSCRIPT LEVELS: Undergraduate transcripts reflect undergraduate coursework. Graduate transcripts reflect graduate course work. Professional transcripts reflect professional coursework. Non credit transcripts reflect credit-bearing coursework earned during a term when the student's curriculum level did not match the course level, or developmental credit earned toward a Comprehensive Transition Postsecondary program approved by the U.S. Department of Education.

ACADEMIC STANDING: Undergraduate students are considered to be in good academic standing unless noted otherwise. See University Catalog (<http://catalog.okstate.edu/>) for definitions of academic notice, probation, and suspension. Prior to Fall 2017, academic standing for graduate students was not reflected on the transcript.

DEGREES: Degrees awarded are listed under the heading "Degrees Awarded" and *include an award date*. Curriculum listed here without an award date indicates the student has applied to graduate but the degree has not yet been awarded.

HONORS DEGREES: Honors Program/Honors College Degree (beginning May 1995) and Degree with Honors (Dec 1989 – Dec 1994) denote additional curricular requirements of University Honors Program/Honors College. Degree with Honors (May 1969 – May 1989) denotes additional curricular requirements of college-based honors programs.

THESIS/DISSERTATION TITLES: Beginning Fall 2017, master's thesis and doctoral dissertation titles display on the transcript. A master's degree with no thesis title indicates a non-thesis option.

SYSTEM CONVERSION: Due to a student records system conversion effective Fall 2016, some differences may exist in the formatting of coursework and degrees earned prior to Fall 2016.
