IMPORTANT:

1. **THIS REPORT IS NOT VALID IF THERE IS ANY ALTERATION.**

2. The integrated comprehensive set of tests consists of five (5) parts organized mainly around the four (4) major nursing goals, that is, Test I Promotive, Test II Preventive, Test III A & B, Curative and Test IV Rehabilitative. The tests still draw basic knowledges, skills and attitudes in the traditional major subject areas, i.e., Fundamentals of Nursing including Professional Adjustments, Maternal and Child Nursing, Community Health & Communicable Disease Nursing, Nursing of Adolescents, Adults and Aged, and Mental Health and Psychiatric Nursing.
3. In order to pass the examination, an examinee must obtain a GENERAL AVERAGE RATING of at least 75% with **no rating below 60%** in any subject. An examinee who obtains an average rating of 75% or higher but gets a rating below 60% in any given subject must take the examination again but only in the subject(s) where he/she rated below 60%. In order to pass the succeeding examination, an examinee must obtain a rating of at least 75% in the subject(s) repeated. An examinee who despite the third examination fails to obtain at least seventy five percent (75%) in the subject or subjects repeated shall no longer be allowed to take the examination unless he/she proves to the satisfaction of the Board that he/she has undergone a refresher course consisting in enrollment and passing the same course in a required nursing school.
