

i.	Singlehandedly created, developed, and implemented an inclusion module to integrate students with special needs into a regular educational system.
ii.	Implemented a series of activities based learning programs, which increased student interest in regular lessons.
iii.	Introduced a novel behavior management program, which reduced incidents of unacceptable behavior by 80%.
iv.	Led a student body for a convention, receiving an award for the best and most intense involvement in the core program.
v.	Successfully implemented the International Baccalaureate program, increasing representation of the school on an international level.
vi.	Researched new materials and resources for a primary school program, resulting in the betterment of students' grades.
vii.	Attained the 'Teacher of the Year Award' in 2022 owing to exceptional contribution to the state education system.
viii.	Created, developed, and implemented an all-encompassing curriculum on a state level, without help from external sources.
ix.	Successfully helped students in college admissions through appropriate and well-placed career counseling.
x.	Reinvented the lesson planning module by incorporating current affairs and international relations as subjects, bringing students to par with their peers from other schools.
