"WHEREAS, it appears that pursuant to the provisions of Chapter IV of Commonwealth Act No. 141, as amended, governing the homesteading of portions of the public domain, the claim of AURELIO MODINA has been established and duly consummated in conformity with law of Raybay Province of Leyte , Island of Luzon , Philippines, containing an area of Lectares, 26 ares, 28 centares, according to the official plat of the survey thereof on file in the Bureau of Lands, Manila, and described on the back hereof;

"Now, THEREFORE, KNOW YE, That by authority of the Constitution of the Philippines, and in conformity with the provisions thereof and of the aforecited Commonwealth Act No. 141 and the Acts supplemental thereto, there is hereby granted unto the said ___AURELIO MODINA, Filipino, of legal age, married to Asuncion Fernandez and residing in Pangasugan, Baybay, , the tract of public land above described; Leyte

"To have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereunto of right belonging unto the said AURELIO MODINA and to his heir or heirs and assigns forever, subject to the provisions of sections 118, 121, 122 and 124 of Commonwealth Act No. 141, as amended, which provide that except in favor of the Government or any of its branches, units or institutions, the land hereby acquired shall be inalienable and shall not be subject to incumbrance for a period of five (5) years next following the date of this patent, and shall not be liable for the satisfaction of any debt contracted prior to the expiration of that period; that it shall not be alienated, transferred or conveyed after five (5) years and before twenty-five (25) years next following the issuance of title, without the approval of the Secretary of Agriculture and Natural Resources; that it shall not be incumbered, alienated, or transferred to any person, corporation, association, or partnership not qualified to acquire public lands under the said Act and its amendments; and that, except with the consent of the grantee and the approval of the Secretary of Agriculture and Natural Resources and solely for educational, religious or charitable purposes or for a right of way, no corporation, association or partnership may acquire or have any right, title, interest, or property right whatsoever to the said land; and subject also to all conditions and public easements and servitudes recognized and prescribed by law, especially those mentioned in sections 109, 110, 111, 112, 113, and 114 of Commonwealth Act No. 141, as amended.
