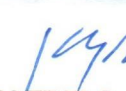

Date: **July 2020** Target Date: **December 2022**

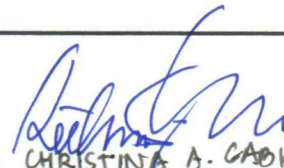
Next Step: Explore ways to grow academically; look for scholarship for PhD studies preferably abroad.
