First Step: Adopt a regular workload for teaching by recruiting more faculty and find more time for making research/extension proposal. For Administration – circulate DAS Memorandum Order and conduct regular monthly meetings to expedite requirement or work demands from top administration.

Result: Recruited 1 regular and 2 part-time instructors to ease teaching workloads. Senior faculty were assigned lecture courses while junior faculty handled laboratory courses. Attendance to Technical Writing Workshop resulted to submission of research proposal for funding and published article in peer-reviewed journal. Also, circulation of DAS Memo Orders and regular conduct of monthly meetings have improved the deliverable outputs of DAS.

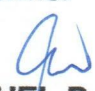
