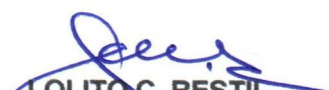

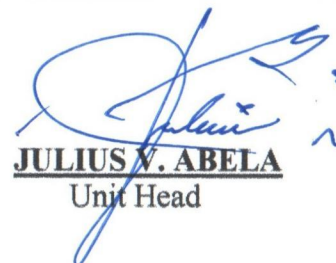

Improved research capability and empowered researchers, expansion of LGUs/NGOs livelihood opportunities in livestock production.

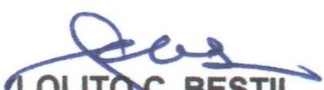
