Dear Dr. Yepes:

Greetings!

Please allow me to monetize at least 50% of my leave credits, for I will be using the money to provide for my father's medication. My father, Mr. Marcelo C. Abrera, was experiencing pain in his abdomen last November 1-2, 2023. I accompanied him for a check-up at Dr. Mante's clinic in Dulag, Leyte. Dr. Mante required him to undergo Blood Chemistry, Urinalysis, and Ultrasound so she could prescribe the correct medicine for his pain. On November 6 & 7, 2023, he underwent such tests in Quali-Serv Diagnostic Imaging Center and R.G. Clinical Laboratory, respectively, both located in Dulag, Leyte. When Dr. Mante saw the results, she highly recommended that my father be admitted to a hospital because of kidney disease and liver cirrhosis. My father talked to me afterward and expressed his strong refusal to be admitted to the hospital. He says he is hopeless and that his body can no longer resist the medical treatment in the hospital. However, he told me that he would like to take herbal treatment/ medications. He has been taking King's Herbal and Intra since then. It seems that these herbal medications are quite effective since my father is no longer suffering from the same pain he had felt before, although I feel the need to have him undergo a follow-up check-up. ULTRASOUND REPORT

The liver has a normal size and coarse parenchymal echotexture with lacelike echogenecities. No hepatic mass. Intact intrahepatic ducts, CBD and vascular channels.

The gallbladder measures 2.6 x 1.3 cm. Wall is smooth and thin. No intraluminal echoes.

The pancreas and the spleen have normal sizes and echotexture.

The kidneys measure: right = 10.0 x 4.7 cm; left = 10.3 x 4.9 cm. Both kidneys have coarse parenchymal echotexture, sandy stones and cortical cysts measuring 2.7 x 2.1 cm in the right and 2.6 x 2.0 cm and 1.1 x 0.8 cm in the left. No ectasia.

The ureters are not dilated.

The urinary bladder has a smooth and thin wall. No intraluminal echoes.

No intra-abdominal mass nor free fluid collection.

IMPRESSION:

- * Liver cirrhosis secondary to schistosomiasis.
- * Partially contracted gallbladder.
- * Renal parenchymal disease, grade 1, sandy nephrolithiasis and renal cortical cysts, bilateral.
- * Normal pancreas, spleen and urinary bladder.
- * Non-dilated biliary tree and ureters.
