I hope this letter finds you in good health and high spirits. I am Noemi Elisa Oquias and I am writing to you today to appeal for the reconsideration of the monetization of service credit.

Unfortunately, I have been diagnosed with adenomyosis and most probably with endometriosis according to my OB, a medical condition that causes severe discomfort, pain, and fatigue particularly during menstruation. These symptoms significantly impact my ability to participate in some traditional service activities, which often require significant time commitments outside of regular work hours and my personal life.

As you may know, managing a medical condition like adenomyosis often requires extensive medical care and treatment, which can incur significant expenses. My last check-up at Perpetual Succor Hospital was March 24, 2023. I have to return for a follow-up check-up on December 2023. Unfortunately, despite my best efforts to manage my finances responsibly, I find myself in a situation where I am struggling to cover the costs of my medical care and related expenses. I have exhausted all my finances during pandemic, when I have to pull out money from my pocket because all my family members got COVID, months passed by my husband suffered from acid reflux and cholecystectomy (gall bladder removal).

Given this situation, I am reaching out to you with a humble request for assistance. Specifically, I am inquiring about the possibility of monetizing my ¹⁵ ~~20~~ ^{fifteen} ~~twenty~~ days service credit for financial support that the university may offer to its employees in need.

I am deeply grateful for your attention to this matter and for considering my request. Your understanding and support during this challenging time would mean a lot to me, not only in terms of alleviating my financial burden but also in providing much-needed peace of mind as I focus on my health and well-being. I am more than willing to provide any documentation or information necessary to support my request and demonstrate the sincerity of my need.
