Despite Filipino youth's potential for innovation, many lack access to entrepreneurship, particularly in agri-aqua sectors. While VSU and a few SUCs in the region have Technology Business Incubators (TBIs), pre-incubation programs encouraging youth participation are limited. Inadequate resources, training, and mentorship further restrict entrepreneurial pursuits, with youth participation in VSU-TBI currently below 10%. The VSU LIYAB project aims to address this
