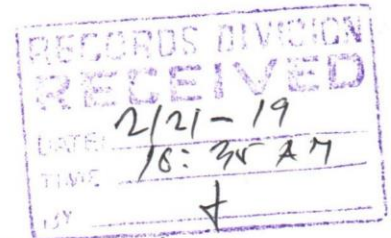

R E: Implementation of VSU Values Restoration Program

In connection to the Philippine Development Plan 2017-2022 and in support to the current administration's thrust "to increase the level of cultural awareness, inculcate values for the common good, cultivate creativity and amplify national pride among Filipinos", VSU had formally launched the Values Restoration Program last September 2018.

VSU is committed in attaining values restoration among its personnel. Identified faculty and staff were sent to the Values Restoration Program Training and now commissioned as Values Restoration Officers (VROs). One of its major activity is a seven-minute value focus sharing during flag ceremony every Monday. Since this has not been fully operationalized, this activity will formally kickoff on **March 4, 2019** at the Administration Building. The Values Restoration Officers will first share the Value Focus for the week.

In view of this, you are hereby requested to strictly implement the seven-minute values sharing during the flag ceremony in your respected area. VROs will assist during its first implementation. For the successive weeks, this will be done by the assigned units/ offices/ departments doing the seven-minute value focus sharing. Offices/units/department who are not conducting flag ceremony every Monday should at incorporate the values-sharing during their monthly meeting. This will strictly be monitored. The office/unit/department will need to submit a documentation report (including photo documentation) on their values focus sharing activity to ODAHRD c/o Ms. Jennifer E. Ando. VROs will then collate the report and submit it to the Civil Service Commission.
