4. Contribute news or feature article about the Department's alumni activity or project or news- worthy achievement. Include title of the activity, number of alumni attendees and other activity highlight and email the list to ACRO.
5. Facilitate sending important google docs to their respective alumni as scheduled.
6. Provide the following data to ACRO every end of June and December of each year:
 - Number of alumni tracer studies conducted in the unit or college
 - Names of alumni from their unit occupying key positions in public or private institutions including NGOs
 - Number of alumni acting as visiting professors/researchers
 - Number of alumni acting as resource persons in trainings, seminars and conferences
 - Number of alumni attending and presenting paper on in-house research review sessions and planning workshops
 - Number of students sent to OJT or internship via alumni facilitation
 - Name of faculty mentored by alumni connected in other institutions
 - Name of alumni receiving an award for their contribution to the university
 - Updated list of campus-based alumni including the newly hired alumni from the unit
