T O : All VISCA Constituents and Drivers of MultiCabs and Other Vehicles

R E : CAMPUS ROUTES FOR VEHICLES

After a series of consultation through Public Forum, meetings, with the President's Advisory Council (PAC) and Administrative Council, this office is hereby informing all the VISCA constituents and vehicle drivers that the old campus routes based on OP Memorandum No. 47, series of 1997 is still enforced, except on the following changes as approved by the Administrative Council:

a. Declared as ONE-WAY STREETS


1. Service road from Mulberry Dorm to the Arts and Letters building allowing only 2-wheeled vehicles to pass. However, four-wheeled vehicles can enter from the main road fronting Physical Education bldg. going up to Molave Dormitory to accommodate the transport needs of the dorm residents in the said area.
2. Service road along the Agricultural Economics and Agribusiness Bldg. going to the FARM/PRCRTC (passing at the back of the DPP building) allowing only the 2-wheeled vehicles to pass with the precaution to STOP before the intersection to look for vehicles going up or down from the hilltop.
3. Road originating from the covered-walk at the Office of Student Affairs going up to the New Administration building.

b. Declared as EXPRESS LANE

1. Road along the Social Plaza going to the hilltop shall be an express lane with no stopping at anytime, while vehicles which will load or unload passengers along the CSR and DAEA buildings shall use the service road fronting the said buildings.

In order to ensure full cooperation, everyone is requested to adopt the meaning of the terminologies agreed by the members of the Administrative Council, which will be the basis also of the Security Force to apprehend traffic violators (See attachment).

This memorandum will take effect on September 1, 1999 and will remain in full force until revoked by this office or higher authorities.
