
**R E: World Teachers' Month Campaign**

SUBJECT: 2009 TEACHERS' MONTH CAMPAIGN

DATE : 30 JUNE 2009

In observance of World Teachers' Day which was proclaimed by UNESCO in 1993, we are re-launching the **Teachers' Month Campaign (TMC)**. The first day of the campaign will coincide with Metrobank's 47<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration on **September 4, 2009** highlighted by the awarding of the **Metrobank Foundation's Search for Outstanding Teachers**, and will culminate on **October 5, 2009 as World Teachers' Day**. The TMC Council of Leaders composed of prominent personalities from business, government and non-government sectors will be at the forefront of the campaign. The Chairman of CHED and Commissioner Nenalyn P. Defensor are involved in this endeavour.

Among the objectives of the TMC are a) to generate widespread awareness and support for Teachers' Day; b) to celebrate the unique role that teachers play in nation building; c) to revitalize the image of teaching as a vocation; d) to enhance the viability of a teaching career through scholarships and subsidy programs; and e) to affirm current and retired Filipino teachers.

All public and private colleges and universities are encouraged to cooperate in the campaign through the following activities:

- 1) Invite everyone who has ever been a student to say "Thank You" to at least one teacher who has made a difference in his or her life by writing a letter or sending a card or a token of appreciation.
- 2) Coordinate with the media in honoring teachers during the one-month celebration and launching a major event on October 5, 2009, World Teachers' Day.
- 3) Conduct special activities to honor teachers.
- 4) Encourage Alumni Associations to initiate projects in support of the campaign.
- 5) Disseminate information on the campaign and feature stories or write-ups on teaching/teachers through their school publications and websites.
- 6) Through various consortia and on a purely voluntary basis, mobilize the support of the community in paying tribute to teachers through discounts/freebies or special promos for teachers for a particular period during the month leading to October 5.

Everyone concerned is directed to disseminate this Memorandum.
