SUBJECT: Protection of Equipment from the Natural Elements

Auditor Alberto M. Abiera called my attention to the fact that some heavy equipment of VisCA, particularly the Rock Crusher, are left exposed to rain and other natural elements which could cause so much corrosion and could render our equipment useless in no time.

In view of this, you are hereby directed to:

1. Pull all equipment to the garage or any shed, and if this is not possible, construct a temporary shed or provide covers to prolong the useful life of the equipment.
2. For the Rock Crusher, explore the possibility of renting this to the Area Equipment Services in Tacloban or other agencies in Leyte, Samar or Cebu in order to help generate income. Also explore the possibility of trading this with dump trucks, since our dump trucks are now quite expensive to maintain.

Immediate action on these matters will be to the advantage of VisCA and the Philippine Government and will be greatly appreciated by all concerned.
