

EVALUATION OF THE AGRICULTURAL SERVICES DELIVERY SYSTEM OF ORMOC CITY

(A Proposal)

Rationale

In response to the Agriculture and Fisheries Modernization Act (AFMA), the City Agriculture and Fisheries Council (CAFC) of Ormoc City proposes an evaluation of the agricultural services delivery system of Ormoc so as to establish benchmark information on the status of agricultural development in the city, in preparation for the AFMA implementation. Evaluation findings can guide the city in strengthening the agriculture sector, which comprises 61 percent of Ormoc's economy.

Since AFMA empowers the State Universities and Colleges in the promotion of extension excellence among local government units in complementation with the Department of Agriculture (DA) to accelerate and sustain agricultural modernization, CAFC shall request the Visayas State College of Agriculture, which AFMA has identified as the Regional University, and DA's Regional Field Unit 8 (DA-RFU 8) and Agricultural Training Institute-Regional Training Center-8 (ATI-RTC 8) to conduct the evaluation.
