For the shoot, please prepare white long sleeves with black tie (for men) and white or light-colored dress (for women), which will be worn under the new green toga. Aside from that, you will wear a Filipiniana attire for another photo. You will take care of your makeup and hairdo, if needed.

For the component colleges, your Chancellor will identify the venue and holding area for the shoot, making sure to comply with minimum health protocols. For the main campus, the venue will be at the VSU Library.

Your department's graduation focal persons (GFPs) will coordinate with you and fill you in with other important information in due course.
