R E: VSU Gender and Development (GAD) Database Committee

Pursuant to the Magna Carta of Women (RA 9710), Section 36 (c) Generation and Maintenance of GAD Database which states that:

all departments, including their attached agencies, offices, bureaus, state universities and colleges, government instrumentalities shall develop and maintain a gad database containing gender statistics and sex-disaggregated data that have been systematically gathered, regularly updated, and subjected to gender analysis for planning, programming, and policy formulation.


and CHED Memorandum Order No 01, Series of 2015, Part XIII. A GAD Database that requires all HEIs to formulate the guidelines on the collection of sex-disaggregated data, conduct interpretation and analysis, and publish its findings, the GAD Database Committee is hereby established.

With Prof. Maria Aurora T.W. Tabada as Chairperson, the Committee is tasked to establish a functional GAD Database in compliance with the above legal mandates and as important inputs to formulating the university's institutional plans and the GAD Agenda and corresponding six-year GAD Plans and Budgets.
