

In the interest of government service and by virtue of the authority vested in me by the VSU Board of Regents, you are hereby designated as **Director, Regional Climate Change Research and Development Center**. As such, you will perform the following duties and responsibilities in addition to your regular functions:

1. Generate science-based knowledge and information on climate change, disaster risk reduction and management and resilience-building, and publications in technical and popular media;
2. Develop alternative climate change mitigation and adaptation options, disaster risk reduction and management measures, and strategies for community resilience-building through technological, behavioral and policy innovations and robust decision support tools;
3. Establish high level of awareness on climate change and positive behavioral change among the vulnerable sectors and other stakeholders;
4. Empower and capacitate Local Government Units (LGUs), civil society organizations (CSOs), and other stakeholders in mainstreaming climate change adaptation and mitigation opportunities, effective disaster risk reduction and management, and resilience-building into the local and national policies and development programs;
5. Forge strong partnership with key player organizations and stakeholders to advance development solutions on climate change, disaster risk reduction and management, and resilience-building concerns.

As Director, you are entitled to the privileges granted and the responsibilities attached to the position subject to pertinent policies.

This designation will take effect on **January 2, 2025 until December 31, 2025** or unless sooner revoked.
