R E: Virtual Deliberation on VSU proposed Records Disposition Schedule (RDS) with NAP Staff

In connection with NAP General Circular No. 1, series of 2009 dated January 20, 2009 under Article III, Rule 7.3 otherwise known as Agency's Records Disposition Schedule (RDS) that each agency shall established an RDS to be accomplished in the prescribed form (NAP Form 2) covering its substantive records and those records not included in the General-Records Schedules to serve as guide in the disposition of records.

Because of VSU's efforts to improve its records management operation, the agency submitted an updated RDS to the National Archives of the Philippines (NAP) early this year to improve our disposition schedule since its approval last July 27, 2010.
