- Prepare schedules and approve requests for the use of instructional media facilities.
- 8. Prepare catalogue and disseminate bulletins regarding available instructional materials and equipment in the College.
- 9. Recommend measures/activities or innovations for the improvement of the Center.
- 10. Perform other functions assigned by the ATEP Coordinator.

The Assistant Coordinator on the other hand shall assist the IMDC Coordinator in the operation and implementation of the activities and programs of the Center.

Your designations shall take effect immediately unless revoked by competent authority.
