dispose of trash by other means. Garbage can be made into
compost and serve as good natural fertilizer for the garden.

3. Avoid throwing of garbage in the trash cans along the streets on weekends when collection is not usually done. Fish and other animal matters are specially attractive to dogs.

Let us all help in preserving the cleanliness of our community. Sanitation is important particularly around residential areas. Please call the attention of your neighbors who are not showing any concern on proper disposal of garbage.
